

AT LAST!

After a long (to say the least!) and undeniably frustrating wait, Halesworth residents will shortly see signs of activity on the old middle school site. Halesworth Campus trustees are thrilled to announce that the end of the long and difficult planning process is now in sight and East Suffolk Council has given us permission to begin construction.

The first event will be the arrival of UK Power Networks on March 31st. They will remove the pylon currently standing on the site of the 3G pitch and lay the electric cables underground. This is expected to take two months at the end of which work can begin to level the land for the 3G pitch. The grass rugby pitch will be laid out on completion of the 3G pitch. Plans will be put in place to ensure all users have access during construction.

Now that our first phase of the two pitches is going ahead, trustees are discussing in more detail the development of the sports centre building and overall landscaping across the site. As part of this process, trustees will be consulting with users and arranging public information events to demonstrate these future developments. We look forward to seeing you and sharing exciting plans for the future of sports in Halesworth.
